Get the focus and leverage available from Theory of Constraints. Add Lean and Six Sigma disciplines.

Within this TOC framework, the disciplines of Lean and Six Sigma make additional contributions by eliminating waste and variation, respectively. Practitioners have given the acronym “TLS” to the combined practice of TOC and Lean Sigma.
